# **Christmas with the Chefs**

December 2, 2017, we held our 29<sup>th</sup> annual scholarship benefit hosted by the American Culinary Federation, Kona Kohala Chefs Association, "Christmas with the Chefs."

This premier holiday party for the island of Hawai'i will celebrate its 30<sup>th</sup> year on December 1, 2018.

The proceeds are directed towards

Hawai'i Community College-Palamanui Culinary Arts Student Scholarship Awards and for ACF chapter members Educational Scholarships. Three \$2000 scholarships are awarded for second year students, three \$2000 scholarships are awarded to incoming students, and three \$2000 scholarships are awarded to students eligible from both classes. For Chefs and Cooks \$500 is available/year for continuing education support.

"Christmas with the Chefs" originated as Christmas at Hulihe'e 30 years ago on December 1, 1989. Jean Hull, Event Founder, presented the concept of showcasing the culinary talents of the Kona-Kohala chefs, complimented by fine wines and Kona coffee as a benefit. It was to be a coordinate fundraiser for Hulihe'e Palace, the Culinary Arts program at Hawaii Community College-West Hawai'i and the Kona-Kohala Chefs Association. She presented this 'formula' on April 4, 1989 to the ACF Kona-Kohala Chefs Association and to Hulihe'e Palace. It was received with much Aloha.
