REQUIRED MATERIALS AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. ACF Kona Kohala Chefs Association of Hawai'i Scholarship Application Cover Sheet
Note: Applicant must be first-time (upcoming fall semester) Culinary Arts major at Hawai'i Community College-Pāalamanui with a 2.5 GPA, or better, from high school or previous college
2. Official transcript(s) from all highest institutions attended (high school or college)
3. Copy of current American Culinary Federation membership card (optional)
4. A 500-word essay, on why you merit this award, which should also express your *commitment* to the culinary industry, your *career goals*, and your *plans* for achieving them
5. List of culinary-related extracurricular/community involvement including names and dates of the event(s) and your level of participation
6. Letters (2, minimum) of recommendation from sources other than relatives about your character, personal qualities, and work ethic
Note: students with culinary experience should ensure one (1) of the recommendation letters is from your Food Service instructor/supervisor
