The American Culinary Federation Kona Kohala Chefs Association is pleased with the progress on the long-awaited Hawai'i Community College - Pālamanui opening in 2015. The ACF members earnest desire is to support the new culinary campus by helping to secure funds for equipment and appliances for the Culinary Arts Program.

There will be four kitchens: two 1200 square foot teaching. one 800 square foot baking and one 800 square foot prep kitchen for a total of 4000 square feet. The facilities will enable 65 students per semester to work toward their AAS degree in Culinary Arts.

The Campaign Goal:

A \$ 200,000 goal of capital funds is being sought to equip the kitchens with equipment and appliances.
